

ADULT 12 TRI-TRADES

CLEARWATER RIVER DENE NATION (CRDN)

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The **Adult 12 / Tri-Trades program** is designed for adult students who want to achieve a Saskatchewan Grade 12 standing while gaining hands-on experience in the skilled trades. Students complete the seven credits required for an Adult 12 while participating in the SIIT Tri-Trades program, which introduces learners to three key construction trades: carpentry, electrical, and plumbing. The program develops job skills, workplace safety knowledge, and trade readiness to support entry-level employment and future apprenticeship opportunities. A minimum of five credits must be at the 30-level.

Areas of study include:

- English Language Arts 30
- Financial Literacy 30
- Mathematics (20 or 30 level)
- Science (20 or 30 level)
- Indigenous Studies 30
- Two 30-level elective credits

Students who successfully complete the Tri-Trades component will earn two 30-level elective credits toward their Adult 12 requirements, helping them meet the requirements for Saskatchewan Grade 12 standing.

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum of 18 years of age and out of high school for at least one year.
- Adult 10 or Grade 10 standing, **or**
- Score at the Adult 12 level on an academic assessment. After you apply, we will contact you to complete the assessment.
- Must be a member of the Clearwater River Dene Nation.
