- Digital Literacy
- Problem Solving and Communication
- Collaboration & Adaptability
- Creativity & Innovation

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum of 18 years of age and out of high school for at least one year.
- You must score at the Adult Essential Skills level on an academic assessment. After you apply, we will contact you to complete the assessment.

FUNDING

- Students living off reserve can apply for Saskatchewan Income Support (SIS) and may be eligible for the Employment and Training Incentive (ETI).
- Student living on-reserve may contact their band for information on possible funding opportunities.

ACCREDITATION

Northlands College

APPLICATION DEADLINE

This program accepts students all year until all seats are taken. If the program is full, qualified students will be put on a waitlist.

SELECTION PROCESS

First Qualified, First Accepted (FQFA)

To be deemed qualified, an applicant must meet the minimum entrance requirements and complete the application procedures which includes providing all required documents.
