PROGRAM OVERVIEW

This program is delivered online in real time, instructor led virtual classes. The Pathways to Adult 12 Virtual Live (Online) Program helps adult learners get ready for Adult 12. You will build your skills in math and communications, along with taking additional courses that count toward your Adult 12 credits. By completing this program, you'll gain a strong foundation and be prepared to move into an Adult 12 program accredited by the Ministry of Education. Students who need to complete Adult 10 for entry into other programs can also achieve this through the Pathways to Adult 12 Program.

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

- Must reside in the Northlands College catchment area.
- Minimum of 18 years of age and out of high school for at least one year.
- Completion of Adult Essential Skills Levels 1 & 2 **or**
- Score at the Adult 10 level on an academic assessment. After you apply, we will contact you to complete the assessment.
- Daily access to a reliable internet connection.
- A personal computer/laptop.

ACCREDITATION

Government of Saskatchewan, Ministry of Education

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- Adult Essential Skills Level 1 and 2 Certificate of Completion, **or** a completed academic assessment showing skills at the Adult 10 level.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

This program accepts students all year until all seats are taken. If the program is full, qualified students will be put on a waitlist.

SELECTION PROCESS

First Qualified, First Accepted (FQFA)

To be deemed qualified, an applicant must meet the minimum entrance requirements and complete the application procedures which includes providing all required documents.
