PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Students in the Automotive Service Technician program will learn how to diagnose, repair, service and maintain advanced mechanical and electrical systems in vehicles, and get plenty of practical, hands-on training.

Applicants should be physically mobile and capable of moderate lifting. The ideal candidate will possess good problem-solving skills, mechanical aptitude, and manual dexterity. A valid driver's license is required to operate and road test motor vehicles.

Graduates of this program will receive a Level 2 credit towards apprenticeship and have transferable skills that can be applied to other trades including agricultural machinery technician, heavy duty equipment technician, and truck and transport mechanic.
