There will be 21 weeks of training and 1 week of direct industry experience achieved by either work placement or through special projects. The program prepares students to layout, assemble, install, test, troubleshoot and repair electrical wiring, fixtures, control devices and related equipment in all types of building and other structures. This program includes all required learning outcomes to meet Saskatchewan Construction Electrician Apprenticeship Technical Training, Level One.
